## **URGENT ALERT!**

**Please act now!!**

With only ten days left in the session, calls must go to the Georgia Senate Rules Committee Chairman Don Balfour and others on his committee, if S.R. 827 has any chance to pass this year. S.R. 827, introduced by Senator Nancy Schaefer, is this year's version of her bill of 2007 requesting withdrawal of the United States from the Security and Prosperity Partnership (SPP) agreement signed in June 2005 by President Bush and the heads of Mexico and Canada. It's a precursor to the North American Union, which will be the western version of the European Union and a major reason the borders have not been secured to prevent illegal entry. Under SPP, borders will be so blurred and travel so unhindered illegal entry will be a thing of the past.

Please call the following, beginning tomorrow and continuing until S.R. 827 is passed. I can't be more definite than that, but Senator Schaefer has been assured her bill will be on the Senate calendar before the end of the session. Your calls are urgently needed!
