Tell Congressmen Barrow and Marshall to vote NO on Federal Health Care.

Rep. Ted Poe (R-TX) described what's happening under the House plan:

“Democrats are trying to use a *sneaky snake oil gimmick*.”

Let's have an up-or-down vote on this bill and not hide behind some procedural *mumbo jumbo!*”

Pelosi's underhanded plan:

- The House plan is to attach an entirely new bill to an existing bill to create the illusion that only half of the bill is receiving a vote, meaning congressmen can go back home and say they didn't vote for Obamacare, just for a special rule to get the bill moving.
- So, a YES vote on the House package is a vote FOR the Senate Obamacare bill.

FACTS:

- The Senate has never voted on the package under debate in the House.
- For a bill to become law, the Constitution requires the House and Senate to vote on identical language in each piece of legislation.

- **A vote for the proposed “fixer” bill is a vote for the Senate Obamacare bill.**
